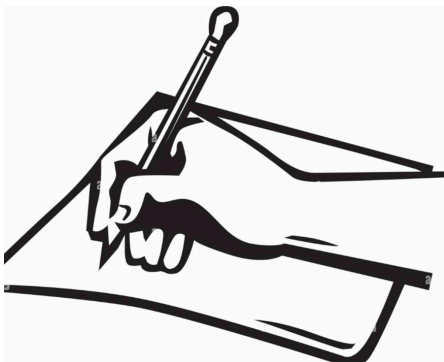

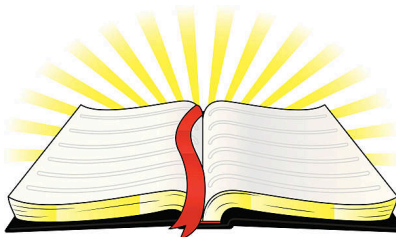


Ladies Adventure Trip

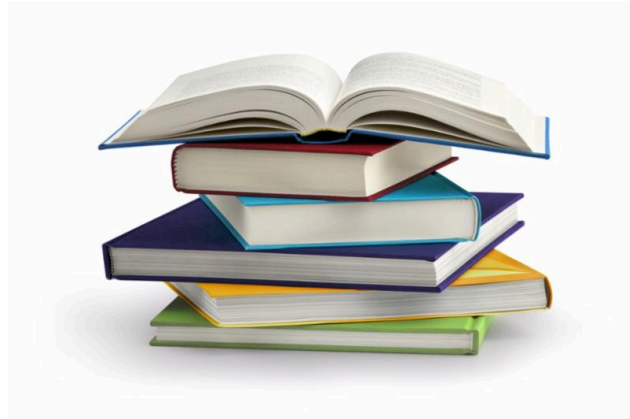
We will leave church a 9:15am to carpool to Arvada. The museum is free and lunch is on your own. Please sign up at the ARK.
