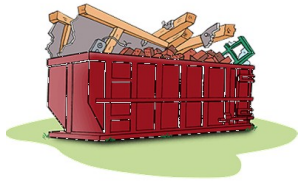

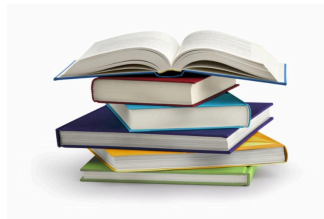
Eastridge Dumpster Day

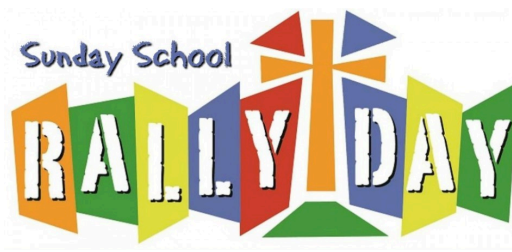

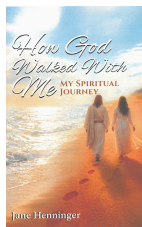

Lyndsay's hours during June, July and August are Mondays and Thursdays from 9-3:30. She will not be in the office on Wednesdays.

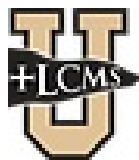
Game Nights
